Guidelines

All applicants and award recipients must abide by Foundation Awards and Grants Policies at all times. A list of current policies is available at www.rheumresearch.org.

Eligibility

- The applicant must meet citizenship and other eligibility requirements as outlined in the Awards and Grants <u>policies</u>.
- The applicant must be a resident enrolled in an ACGME-accredited pediatric, medicine or combined medicine/pediatric residency program who is interested in rheumatology.
- The applicant must be an author or co-author of an abstract submitted to the 2017 ACR/ARHP Annual Meeting via the ACR/ARHP abstract submission portal by the **Monday, June 19 at Noon ET** deadline.
- The applicant must have made a significant contribution to the work submitted in order to be considered for the award.

Review Criteria

Each application will be ranked on the following criteria:

- 1. Evidence of abstract submission
- 2. Applicant's interest in the field of rheumatology
- 3. Support of nominee from faculty member
- 4. Accomplishments, track record and experiences of applicant

Applicants will be notified as to the status of their award in September.

Award Terms and Funding

Awardees will receive an award of \$750, plus reimbursement up to \$1,000 for travel expenses (including air fare, hotel and meals) to attend the 2017 ACR/ARHP Annual Meeting. Awardees will also receive complimentary registration for the meeting. This is a one-year award.

Limited to one page.

- b. Details regarding their past achievements and future career plans.

Letter of Recommendation

Limited to one page.

The mentor must provide a letter of recommendation detailing the resident's contributions to the research project and any achievements.

Please include the following:

- a. Author's name(s)
- b. Abstract control number (from ACR/ARHP submission portal)
- c. A copy of the complete abstract. Applications received without a copy of the abstract submitted to the ACR/ARHP Annual Meeting will **not** be reviewed.

Please note that the Foundation does not have any information regarding the status of your abstract submission to the ACR or ARHP. The ACR/ARHP abstract selection process and the Foundation award selection process are conducted independently.
