# Purpose

The purpose of this supplemental award is to provide funding to enhance fellows’ knowledge and training in osteoporosis and metabolic bone health. Fellowship Program Directors (FDP) applying for the [Fellowship Training Award](#) or the [Fellowship Training Award for Workforce Expansion](#) may elect to receive additional funds to support their fellow(s)’ participation in approved training opportunities. These supplemental funds are made possible through the **Andrew J. Laster, MD Fund for Education and Training in Metabolic Bone Disease**.

# Award Amount

Up to \$7,500

All applications must be submitted via the Fellowship Training Award or Fellowship Training Award for Workforce Expansion online by 5:00 PM ET on the deadline day through [ProposalCentral](#).

# Award Eligibility and Guidelines

All award recipients must abide by Foundation [Awards and Grants Policies](#) at all times.

- Applicant (FPD) must complete application for the [Fellowship Training Award](#) or the [Fellowship Training Award for Workforce Expansion](#) and meet all eligibility requirements of the respective award.
- Applicant (FPD) must be accepted for funding via the Fellowship Training Award or the Fellowship Training Award for Workforce Expansion in order to receive the supplement award.
- Applicants must address all additional questions relevant to the supplemental grant listed on the application to be considered for funding.

## Review Criteria

Applications for supplemental funds will be reviewed based on all components of the proposal with emphasis on the following:

- Justification of the need for supplemental funds to train fellows in metabolic bone health and osteoporosis.
- Explanation of how the funds will be used to improve the curriculum of the training program long-term.
- Priority will be given to programs that do not already have substantial training available in metabolic bone health or osteoporosis.
- Priority will be given to programs that do not already have a substantial budget to send fellows to continuing education opportunities such as the options listed for this supplemental award.

All applications undergo rigorous peer review in their assigned study section and are scored and ranked according to the review criteria and overall merit of the proposal. All study section recommendations are sent to the Foundation's Scientific Advisory Council for review before being presented to the Foundation's Board of Directors for final approval.

# Award Terms and Funding

Supplemental award funds must be used during the award period. Funding will not be released until the Foundation receives executed Condition of Award agreements for the corresponding Fellowship Training Award or Fellowship Training Award for Workforce Expansion.

Recipients will receive up to \$7,500 to be used specifically for participation in one of the approved training opportunities listed in this document, or any proposed activity relevant to osteoporosis or metabolic bone disease. Approved expenditures include registration costs, airfare, housing accommodations, and/or certification/membership fees. Funds will be disbursed along with first award payment in July 2027. Supplemental funds may not duplicate support already provided through other training grants for the same activity.

At the close of the award term, the recipient must provide the Foundation with a final financial reconciliation and details of the use of supplemental funds during the award period. All unexpended supplemental funds at the end of the award period must be returned to the Foundation.

Program director applying for supplemental funds is expected to participate in all final reporting requests to assess the effectiveness of and improve the supplemental grant.
